01 / BEGIN GENTLY

What stayed with you first: an image, an argument, a character, or a feeling?

02 / LOOK CLOSER

Which passage changed your understanding? What in the text led you there?

03 / MAKE ROOM FOR DISAGREEMENT

What did you question or resist? Can someone offer a different reading?

04 / NOTICE THE MISSING VOICE

Whose perspective is absent? How might the book change if they told it?

05 / CONNECT IT TO LIFE

Did this book echo an experience or challenge an assumption? Share only what feels comfortable.

06 / LEAVE WITH A QUESTION

What is still unresolved? What would you like to read, discuss, or investigate next?

A few agreements

Agree on spoilers before you start. Passing on a question is always okay.

Disagree with an interpretation without dismissing the reader.

Leave space for quieter voices. No one needs to have finished the book.
